which was the life-work of my father, Richard Cadbury, of Birmingham. This book has now passed into the possession of my brother, Barrow Cadbury, who has kindly lent it to me for the reproduction of the pedigree, thus making it possible for all members of the family to share its interest.

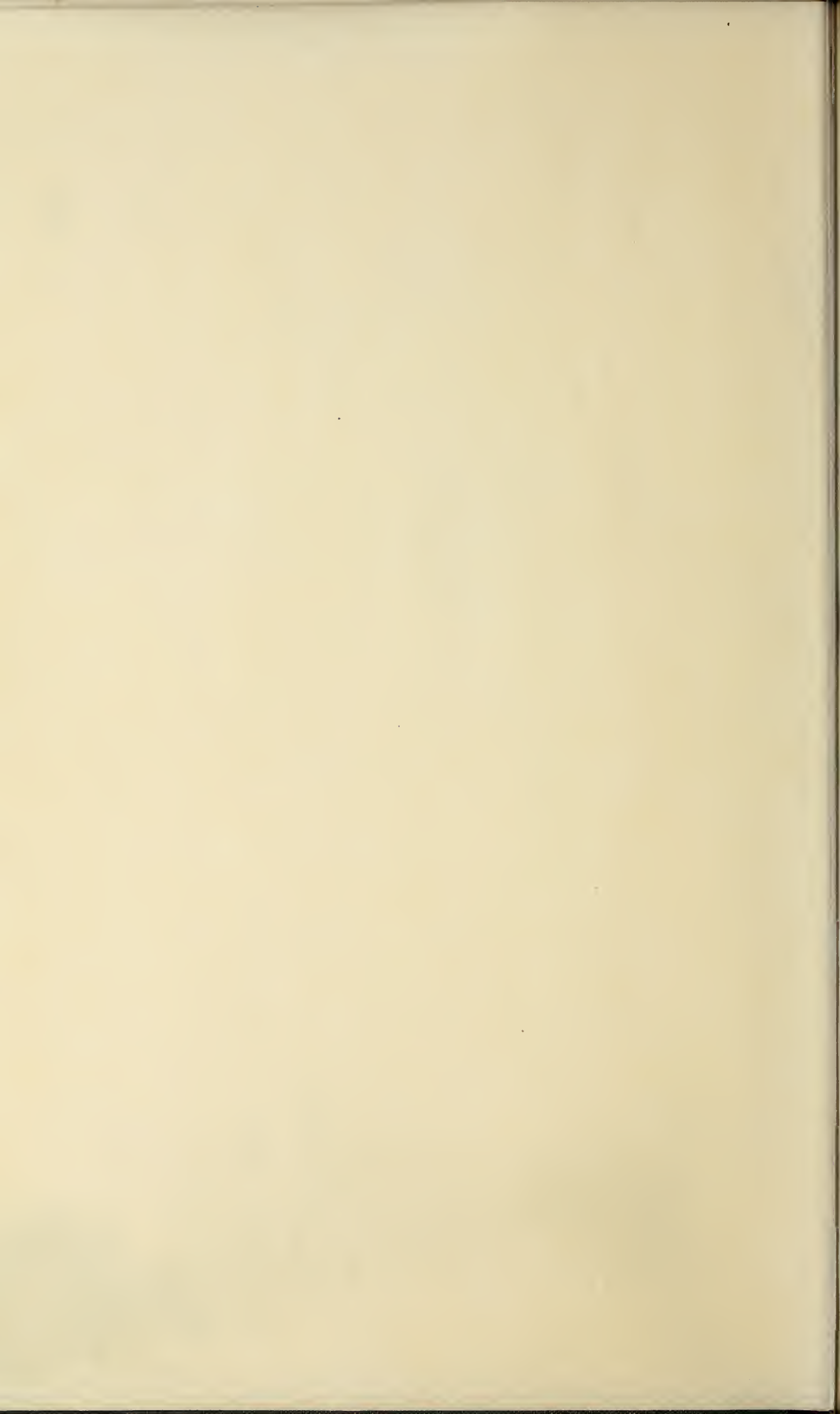
Chart No. 1 is copied almost entirely from The Family Book; my father obtained much of this information by intricate research in old wills and among parish registers in the counties of Devonshire and Somerset, and appears to have quite satisfactorily proved the relationship of all individuals named on this chart with two exceptions; as I cannot find his authority for these, I have made a note to that effect on the chart.

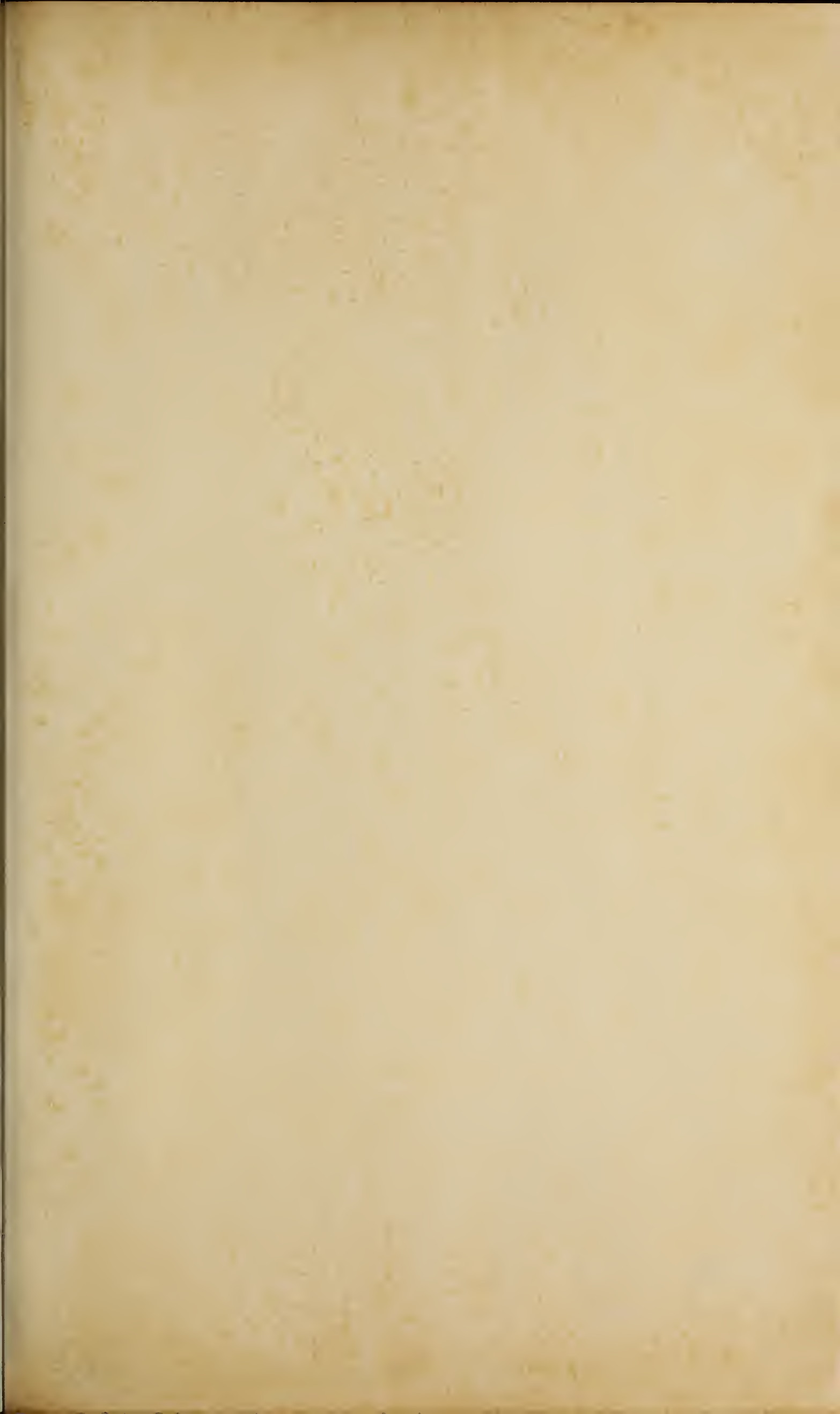
Charts Nos. 2 and 3. The names and figures on these charts have been carefully checked, and I am indebted to relations named in each case for their kind help in completing the different branches of the family. As a general rule, I have adopted the principle of printing all particulars of children of daughters born “Cadbury,” but have not given the names of their grandchildren, as this would make the whole too cumbersome, but in each of these cases it will be a simple matter for a future generation to continue their branch of the family.

With all the care taken and much kind help from others, I realise that mistakes may still occur, and I shall be obliged if I may receive corrections at any time, stating the authority for the correction.

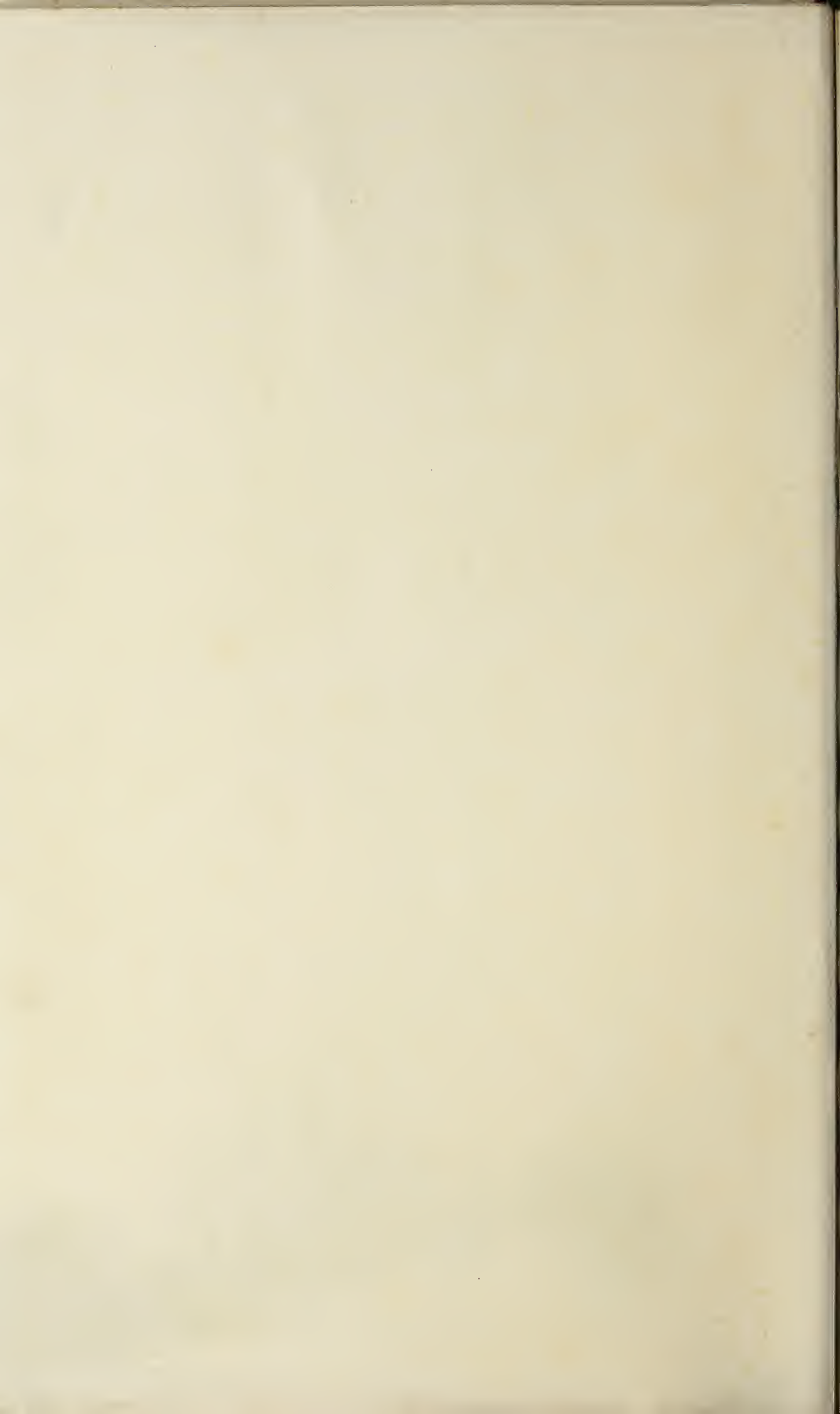
